

# ARE YOU A "KINDA SORTA" CHRISTIAN?

## LESSON #1

## TEACHER'S GUIDE

### LESSON OVERVIEW

**Big Idea:** A real Christian knows Jesus like he's a best friend.

**Key Question:** How can we get to know Jesus?

**Memory Verse:** *Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did.* **1 John 2:6**

**Overview:** We're starting a new series today about what it really means to be a Christian. A Christian is just another name for a follower of Jesus. Let's start with a question. Is it easy to come up with a list of things you love to do? How about a list of things you hate to do. Pretty easy, right? But, it would probably take a little longer to come up with a list of things you only kind of like to do. The reason- you don't feel as strongly about the stuff you only kind of like, so you won't put as much effort toward those things. Did you know that's how many people view their relationship with God? They kind of know him, but not really. So, God isn't really a big priority in their lives because they only kinda sorta care about him. God doesn't want us to relate to him this way. God wants to be our best friend. He wants to be on our list of things we love. Ask yourself the question, "Am I a kinda sorta Christian or do I know Jesus like a best friend?" Here are a few things you can do to be sure you're not a "kinda sorta" Christian. Do things like: read your Bible everyday, pray, go to church, be kind and forgiving to your friends and obey your parents. See, if we really know Jesus like a best friend, then we will spend time with him and we will act like him. Don't be a "kinda sorta" Christian. Make Jesus a priority in your life and get to know him like a best friend!

### CLASSROOM AGENDA

- 5 min **PLAY:** Begin working on Activity Page #1.
- 5 min **WARM UP:** Make a list of things you love to do and a list of things you hate to do. Then, make a list of things you kind of like doing.
- 5 min **PREVIEW:** Write out the Big Idea and Memory Verse and Key Question on a whiteboard. Have the kids copy it down on Activity Page #1. (if applicable)
- 20 min **LARGE GROUP:** Gather for songs and videos with other kids. Then return to small group to finish this guide.
- 5 min **RECAP:** Read the **Lesson Overview** from the Teacher's Guide to the class and then **answer** the KEY QUESTION.
- 5 min **EXPLORE:** Read [Isaiah 29:13](#). What do you think it means that people honor God only with their words? Why does it matter what's in your heart?
- 10 min **PLAY:** Do the group activity from Activity Page #2.
- 5 min **CLOSE:**
  - What will you do this week to spend more time with God?
  - Share prayer requests and pray as a class.

### TEACHER TIPS

Don't forget that you set the tone for your kids. Smile. Have fun. Pursue God together.

Allow each kid to share. The point: We can usually come up with the stuff we love and hate pretty easily. But, identifying things we only sort of like might be harder because we aren't as passionate about those things. We need to make sure we don't treat our relationship with God in a kinda sorta way.

**Answer:** We need to spend time with him doing things like:

1. Reading the Bible
2. Praying everyday
3. Going to church

The more time we spend with Jesus, the more we will understand who he is and how we should act.

**Bonus Questions:** Who do you like to spend time with in your life? What can you do to spend more time with Jesus?

**4-5th:** Why is it important to spend time with Jesus? How does knowing Jesus affect our lives?

You've probably heard the saying, "actions speak louder than words". It's easy to **say** we love God or that we are a Christian but it is a much different thing to actually act like we love God. A true follower will obey what the Bible says and will live everyday to honor God. The **heart** matters because it determines what we care about. If in your heart you don't care about God, then that will come out in the way you think and act. But, if in your heart you love God, then you will think and act like him.

Allow each kid to share. Remind them to read their Bibles, pray and go to church.

# ACTIVITY PAGE #2

## Classroom Activities K-1st

### Option #1

#### How Well Do You Know the Bible?

- Put the pre cut verses (**page 5**) face down on a table
- Have one kid come up and choose a square and give to the teacher
- Read the verse to the class. Have the kid who chose the verse guess in which Testament that verse is found. Have them drop the verse in the correct bag. Make sure to say to the class, "This verse comes from the OT or NT".
- **The goal of the game is to get them more acquainted with the Bible.**

#### Supplies needed

- 2 paper bags with Old Testament written on one and New Testament on the other
- verse template (pg 5), pre cut, one set per class

#### Bonus Activity:

Play the **Telephone** game.

Have kids sit in a circle. Whisper the **Big Idea** in the ear of one kid. Have them whisper it in the ear of the kid to their right. Continue around the circle. Last person has to say the message they heard.

### Option #2

#### Jesus Has My Heart Puzzle Craft

- Give each kid a pre cut heart puzzle template (**page 6**)
- Give each kid a piece of construction paper
- Have kids put the pieces together to form a heart and have them glue the pieces to the construction paper
- Remind the kids as they work that if Jesus is their best friend then they will spend time doing the things listed on their puzzle pieces

#### Supplies needed

- heart puzzle template (pg 6), pre cut, 1 per kid
- construction paper, 1 piece per kid
- glue

#### Bonus Activity:

Play the **Memory Verse** game

Say the memory verse as a class. Say it again while **spinning** around. Say it again while **jumping** up and down.

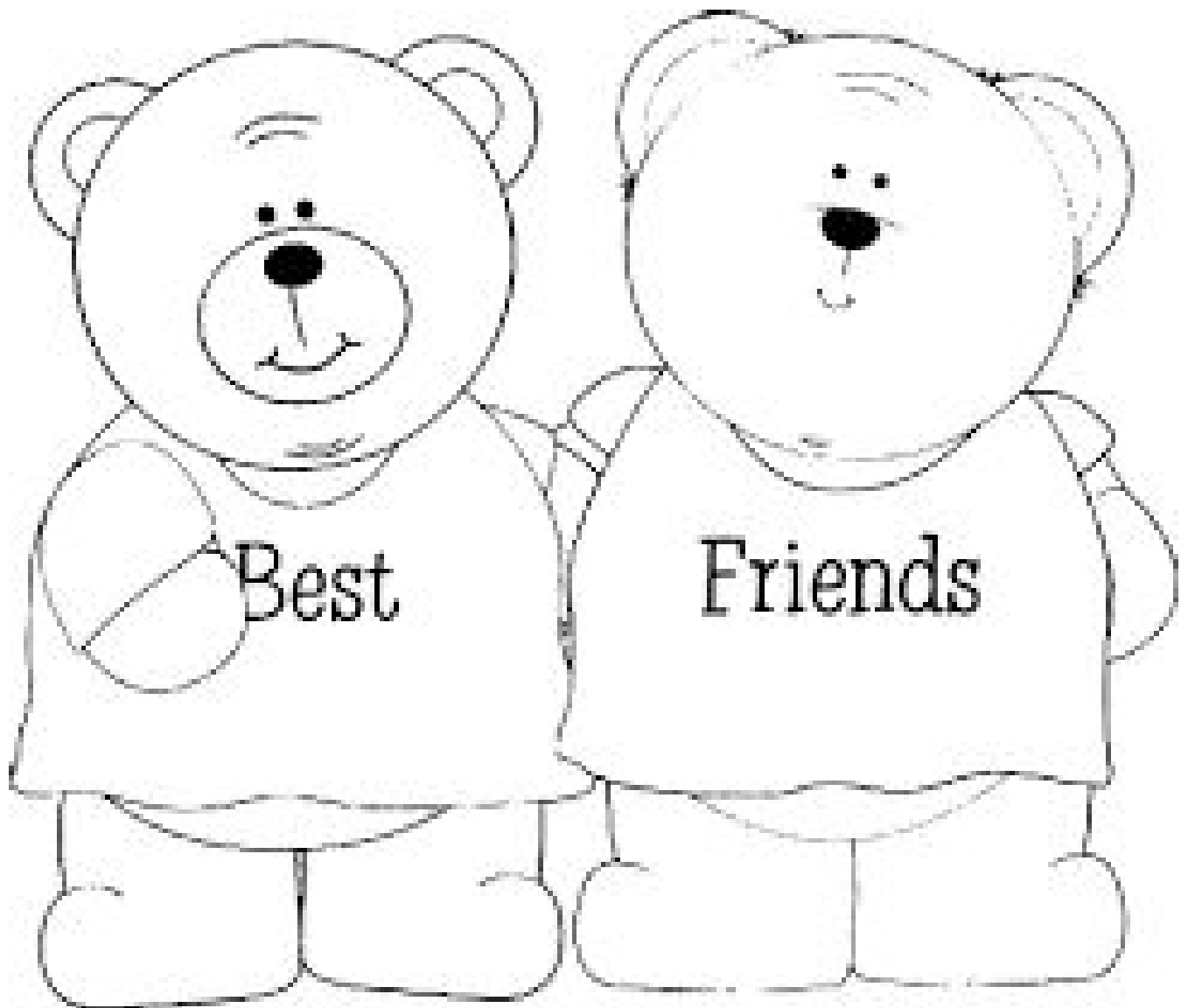
