TEACHER'S GUIDE

LESSON OVERVIEW

Big Idea: The Bible tells us what is true and false. **Key Question:** Why did Jude write this letter?

Memory Verse: In the last days, some people will make fun of the truth. They will follow their own ungodly desires.

Jude 1:18, NIRV

Overview: The book of Jude may be one of the smallest books in the Bible but it has a very big message. The book was written by a guy named Jude. He was an important person in his day. He was the younger brother of Jesus and was one of the key leaders that helped to strengthen the early church. He traveled around to different cities teaching the people about Jesus and what He did for them on the cross. Jude was also concerned about certain people who were telling lies about Jesus. They said things like, "it's okay to do whatever you want" and even tried to confuse people by saying that what Jesus did on the cross wasn't true. This made Jude angry. He warned the followers of Jesus to stand up to lies and to listen only to the truth. Did you know that's true for us today, too? We need to be careful not to believe everything we hear. We should compare everything we hear with the Bible. If it goes against what the Bible says, then we shouldn't believe it. That's why God gave us the Bible; so we could know what is true and what is false.

TEACHER TIPS

Don't forget that you set the tone for your kids. Smile. Have fun. Pursue God together.

Allow each kid to share. The point: Receiving things in the mail is fun. It's a fun way to receive messages from other people. The book of Jude was a letter written to a group of people with a very important message.

Answer: He wanted to warn the people not to believe lies but to stand up for the truth.

The Bible is God's word. It is the truth. He gave it to us so we could know what is right, wrong, true and false. That's why it's so important to read your Bible so you know what the truth is and can identify a lie when you hear it.

Bonus Questions: How do you feel when a friend tells you something that isn't true? Why is lying a bad thing? How often do you read your Bible?

4th-5th: What do you think it was like for Jude to be the little brother of Jesus? What do you think would've been hard for Jude?

God never lies and He never breaks a promise. We can trust that God will always come through on what He says. That's why He gave us the Bible so we can know the truth and be protected from lies.

Give each a kid a chance to share something they learned from today's lesson.


